CSA MEMBERSHIP

This Community Supported Agriculture Project (CSA) for the Fall 2010 season is for those members who pay for a weekly delivery of seasonal produce over a ten-week harvest season. Receiving this payment for shares upfront assists Wood Duck Farm with the purchase of seeds costs, organic fertilizers, fuel, equipment, labor and other farm related expenses.

### WHAT WILL MEMBERS RECEIVE?

Members will receive 5 to 8 different types of vegetables and herbs each week during the growing seasons. Our farm grows several varieties of vegetables and will strive to give members the best quality produce possible. The ten-week season should include cucumbers, summer and winter squash, salad mix, baby arugula, broccoli, cauliflower, spinach, swiss chard, herbs, beans, tomatoes and other varieties that can be grown in southeast Texas during the fall growing season. Wood Duck Farm may work with other local farms to supply our weekly member shares that have the same commitment to growing high quality produce.

### WHAT IS THE COST?

This Fall 2010 CSA program exists for 10 weeks with late September to Early December being the proposed harvest period. A finite number of shares exist, so when the program is full, a waiting list will begin. Share sizes are \$330 for a Full Share (\$33/wk). A Partial Share is \$220 (\$22/wk) for a ten-week program.

### ADDITIONAL MEMBERSHIP BENEFITS

Members will be provided a weekly newsletter as well as receive recipes as to how to prepare some of the weekly produce they receive. Prepared foods items may be purchased for an additional fee.

### SHARING IN THE HARVEST

As a member of the Fall 2010 CSA program, I will anticipate 5 to 8 different types of produce per week for a ten-week period. The weekly amounts may vary in size depending on the time of the harvest season. I understand that the variety of produce that I receive is dependent upon growing and environmental conditions and as such I will share in the risks associated thereof. I further understand that share sizes could be impacted by adverse weather and other acts of God.
